- 3) Disadvantages – who is adversely affected by this project/initiative?
- 4) What alternatives might exist to the project/initiative being proposed? Could things be done better via a different solution?
- 5) Your overall recommendation – based on your analysis do you agree with the project/initiative? Explain why you agree or disagree.

Include a link to the article you reference for this paper. I want you to scour the news sources, but if you have difficulty finding a topic email and I'll lend some help. This is good practice for your conflict summary.
